Itinerary

Day 1: Arrive Zambezi National Park

Your discovery of Zimbabwe commences on arrival in Victoria Falls, with lunch at the iconic Victoria Falls Hotel and a visit to see the falls known locally as the 'Smoke that Thunders'. Continue to Mpala Jena, your intimate and luxurious camp in the Zambezi National Park.

Day 2: Zambezi National Park

Today enjoy a morning and afternoon activity in the Zambezi National Park. Choose from game drives, guided walking safaris and boat trips on the Zambezi River.

Day 3: Victoria Falls - Hwange National Park

Depart Victoria Falls by light aircraft south to Hwange National Park, the country's largest. Hwange is legendary for its vast array of wildlife, particularly the massive herds of elephant and buffalo. Your base is the exclusive and luxurious Linkwasha Camp situated near the famed Ngamo Plains, one of the best game viewing locations in Hwange National Park.

Days 4-5: Hwange National Park

Spend two days exploring Hwange. This park is one of the best for predators - lion, leopard, wild dog and cheetah are regularly sighted, along with the smaller African wildcat, serval, honey badger, civet and spotted hyena. Bird life in the area is also prolific, with more than 400 species found.

Day 6: Hwange National Park - Lake Kariba

Fly to Lake Kariba where you are transferred to Bumi Hills Safari Lodge, boasting one of Africa's finest wilderness locations with elevated position on a range of remote hills overlooking the vastness of Lake Kariba.

Days 7-8: Lake Kariba

The next two days are spent exploring Lake Kariba with game viewing by boat and 4WD in the Matusadona National Park plus excellent fishing opportunities. Birdlife is prolific and walking safaris a highlight.

Bumi Hills Safari Lodge | Meals: BLD**Day 9: Lake Kariba - Sapi Reserve**

Fly to the private 128,000-hectare Sapi Private Reserve. It borders the Mana Pools National Park to the west and forms part of a mission to convert vast tracts of Africa into pure conservation land. It is now recognised as one of the finest wildlife destinations in Africa today. Stay at the luxurious Tembo Plains Camp, tucked away into a thick riverine forest on the edge of the Zambezi River. Activities on offer include day and night drives, boating, canoeing and guided walks.

Tembo Plains Camp | Meals: BLD**Days 10-11: Sapi Reserve**

Enjoy two days exploring this beautiful part of the world, renowned for its large numbers of elephant, buffalo, hippo and eland. Predators such as lion, leopard and wild dog are also found here. Birdlife is superb, particularly for both mopane woodland and riverine species.

Tembo Plains Camp | Meals: BLD**Day 12: Sapi Reserve - Depart Harare**

Farewell as you end your safari with a flight back to Harare airport.

Bumi Hills Safari Lodge, Lake Kariba



Bumi Hills has 20 en suite rooms (divided into standard and premium depending on the size and location). The premium rooms are larger both in bedroom and bathroom with a better lake view and more privacy. The lodge is nestled in the natural bush on top of the hills and offers both a cooling breeze and fantastic views of the lake. Dinners are served in the formal dining room or more usually, on the terrace overlooking the lakeshore. A new feature at Bumi Hills is the spa with sauna, steam room, cold water plunge pool, massage tents, relaxation area and sundeck.
